







Go-Hoard<sup>™</sup> PVC hoarding panels qualify for our plastic waste collection scheme; at end-of-life we can arrange collection of the panels to recycle them into new products for the construction sector.



# What is Our Waste Collection Scheme?

The plastic waste collection scheme is a working project to reduce construction site waste sent to landfill by arranging collection, recycling and re-using of plastic waste. Construction products that fall within the plastic waste category include fluted polypropylene, signage boards, guttering, drainpipes, PVC window frames, external cladding and PVC temporary protection materials.



## How Our Recycling Scheme is Supporting a More Sustainable Construction Sector

We have a dedicated recycling facility in the midlands with state-of-the-art machinery that can recycle most forms of plastic irrespective of minor waste contamination (such as adhesive tapes).

We're currently recycling over 10 million kilos of plastic every year, turning waste plastic into reusable products in the construction sector.
